

NAMING OF STREETS

Previous policy number: 2.2.10

Policy Statement

To establish a procedure for the selection of street names.

Policy Details

- Streets shall be renamed to avoid duplication when through traffic is prevented by the creation of two or more cul-de-sacs from a single street. Applications to formally allocate a street name to a privately owned access to a battle-axe lot be refused.
- The selection of street names for approval by the Geographic Names Committee or other approving authority shall be in accordance with the preferred list of names and in the order predetermined by the Council.
- Where a preferred list of names is established, the Council shall seek public input into the process.
- The Council may submit names not included in the predetermined list of names or not in the predetermined order, where the Council considers it appropriate to do so.
 In these circumstances the Council may seek public input into the process.
