Policy Statement

Advertising signs shall be permitted where they relate to the activity being undertaken on the property and they comply with the provisions of Council's Signs Local Law.

Policy Details

To formalise the circumstances for permitting the provision of advertising signs within the district.

Definitions

Advertising signs: are defined as meaning any board, sign, model, placard, notice, device or representation on which words or number or figures or other features or emblems are written, placed, affixed or painted for the purpose of advertising any business, function, operation, event or undertaking or any product or thing whatsoever, and includes any vehicle or trailer or other similar stationary object placed or located so as to serve the purpose of advertising any business, function, event, product or undertaking.
