

# **FAQ SHEET - DINGHY STORAGE**

#### **OVERVIEW:**

The purpose of this information sheet is to answer some of the common questions posed to the Town about the storage of Dinghy's along the Mosman Park foreshore.

### How do I apply to get a dinghy storage plot? How are they allocated?

The application for dinghy storage form can be found on the Towns website and is available from the administration building. As per Policy 2.2.13 Dinghy Management the storage plots are allocated in the following order of priority;

- 1. Long Term Mooring Holders who are Mosman Park Residents
- 2. Long Term Mooring Holders who are NOT Mosman Park Residents
- 3. Small water craft owners who are Mosman Park Residents
- 4. Small water craft owners who are NOT Mosman Park Resident

If all storage plots are utilised, the applicant will be placed onto the waiting list and once a storage plot becomes available as per the order of priority (above) they will be contacted.

#### When will I receive my invoice for my registration?

Registrations are for a 12 month period, expiring on June 30 each year. Invoices for reoccurring storage will be issued each year in July.

### How much is the register per year? Why has the fee increased?

The annual fee for the registration is \$368.50 – when the storage plots were first introduced the initial fee was lower being a new service. Council did have the intention to increase the fee to reflect the true cost of having the storage plots. The annual fee covers administration costs, the GRV of the land, maintenance etc.

#### Where do I put my registration tag from the Town on my dinghy?

Your registration tag must be attached to your dinghy and be easily visable at all times. We recommend looping the tag through the chain loop attached to the base of your vessel.

#### Can I sub-lease my storage plot?

No, the 'on-selling' gifting of storage bays to third parties or family members will result in the immediate forfeit of the storage bay and any remaining fees.

### How many storage poles are available in Mosman Park?

The following allocations of storage bays are proposed and approved by DBCA;

I.	Mosman Bay – North	Up to 18 bays
II.	The Coombe Reserve	Up to 23 bays
	Total Dinghy bays	Up to 41 bays
