Suggested clearer wording:

That before Council decides the preferred option for ongoing use of Memorial Hall, a summary of submissions made to the Memorial Hall survey is provided to submitters.

At the Meeting

- You will be required to propose your motion
- A seconder will be required before it can be discussed
- If no seconder, the motion will lapse and will not be considered
- You will then have the opportunity to provide more information for your motion
- Once you are finished, other residents present are invited to speak to your motion
- A vote by those present at the meeting will then take place. The vote is just to accept the motion for consideration
- The Administration will provide feedback on the motions at the March 2024 Ordinary Council Meeting
